

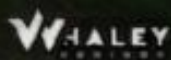

***Terry Royale Grigsby was born on July 1, 1994, in Omaha, Nebraska, to Terry and Joyce Grigsby. He was affectionately known to many as "Little Terry," despite towering over his dad, or "LT," as Uncle Ed would call him. Terry was a loving son, brother, nephew, cousin, coach, and friend. He was also a gifted athlete who excelled in track, football, and basketball.***

***Terry began his educational journey at Lothrop Elementary School, where he attended kindergarten. He later transferred to Conestoga Elementary School, completing first through third grades, before moving on to Jesuit Middle School. It was at Jesuit where his heart and mind were prepared to embrace the commitment to service as a "Man for Others," shaping the character of the young man he became. From there, he attended Omaha North High School, where his path crossed with thousands of student-athletes across the state, many of whom he remained connected with. He was supported by numerous teachers who encouraged him to excel beyond average in the classroom. Special thanks are extended to Coach Martin, Coach G.A. (R.I.P.), and other coaches who recognized and developed his athletic skills, talents, and abilities.***

***Terry was named an All-Nebraska defensive back in 2011 and also played wide receiver at Omaha North High School. He continued his football career at Southeast Missouri State in 2012 and later at the University of Nebraska at Kearney in 2015. Terry went on to coach wide receivers on Coach Martin's staff at Omaha North High School. As an athlete with a passion for coaching and teaching, he later became a coach for the Peak Performance Track and Field youth team. His belief in and ability to motivate others led him to a career at King Science and Technology Magnet School, where he made sure every student knew they had value and purpose.***
