



Obituary

Monica Evette Huggins, 52, of Thorndale, PA, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, August 1, 2023, at her residence.




In addition to her parents Johnnie O Huggins, Sr., and Elizabeth Huggins, she was preceded in death by her son's father, Daniel Carter.
