# OBITUARY

**Brigitte Yvonne Feaster** was born on July 1, 1971, to loving parents Ulyless Gaither Roach and Jeff Feaster. Being a member of a large family, Brigitte grew up surrounded by the love and attention of many cousins, aunts, and uncles as well as her parents.

Brigitte was educated in Rock Hill public schools and in 1989 she graduated from Northwestern High School where she was a member of the track team and the ROTC (Reserve Officers' Training Corps) program.
