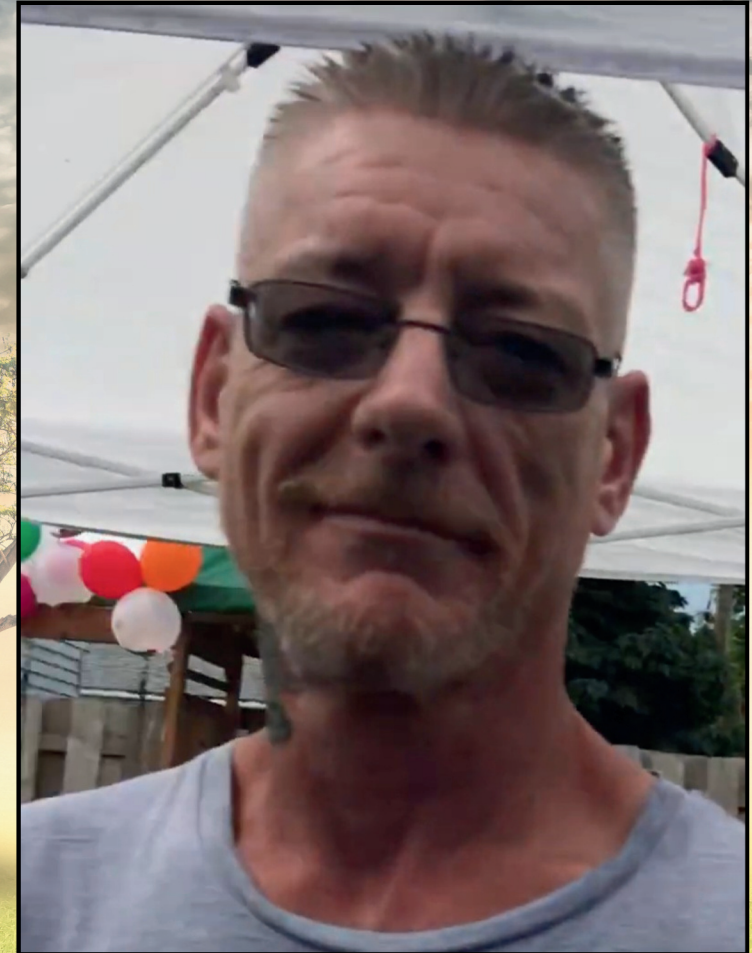
Keith was a proud yet humble man with a remarkable ability to think outside the box and solve problems. He was a skilled machine operator who took pride in his work at The Pallet Company.
