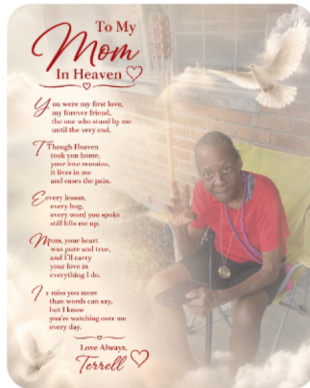


*To My Aunt in Heaven
