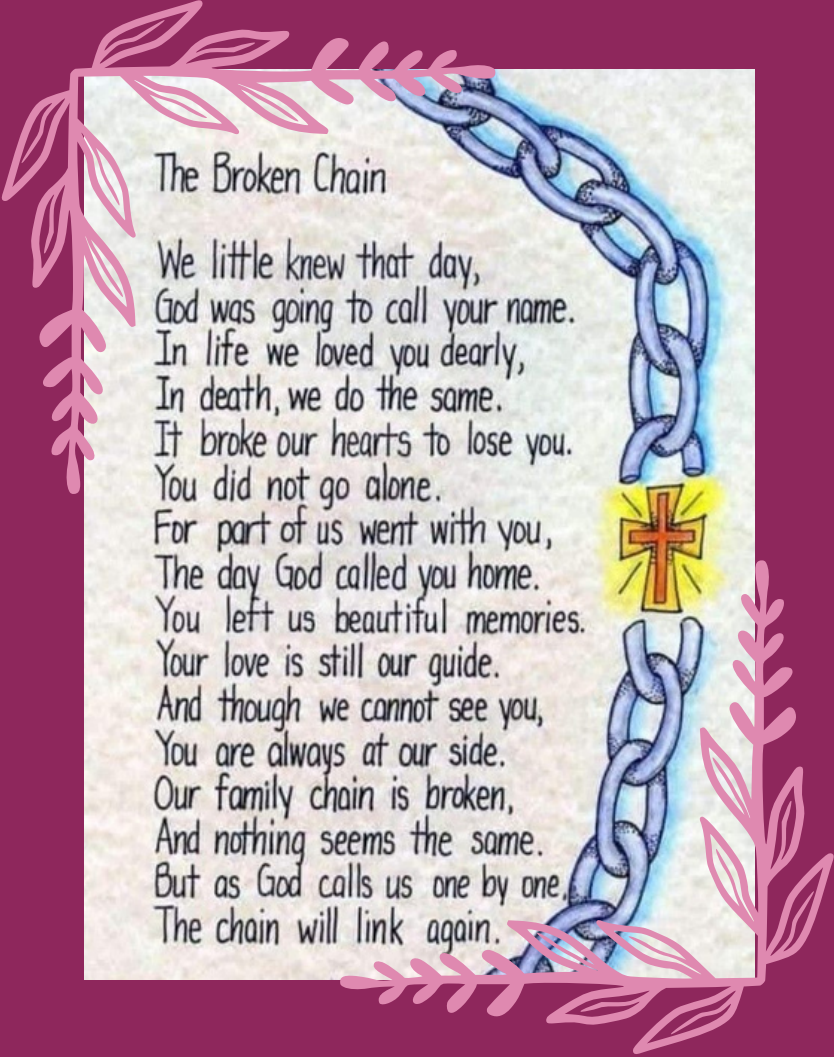

Her story

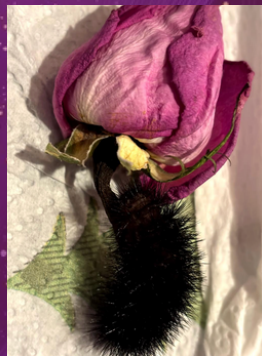
