FOREVER IN OUR HEARTS REMEMBERING DAVID

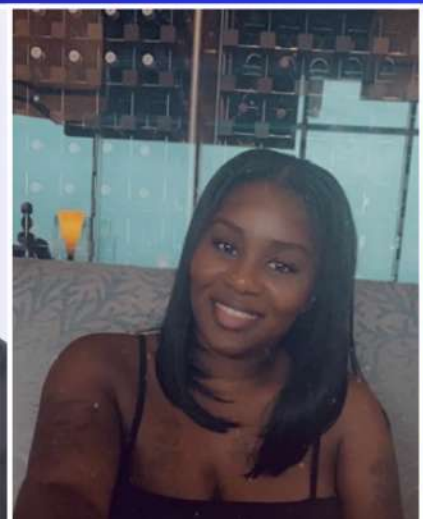
Ecclesiastes 3:1-2
