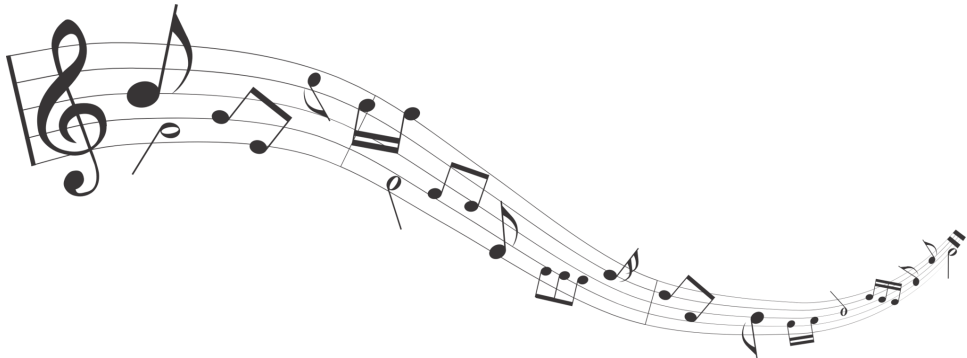

A private family service will be held to honor Paul's memory.

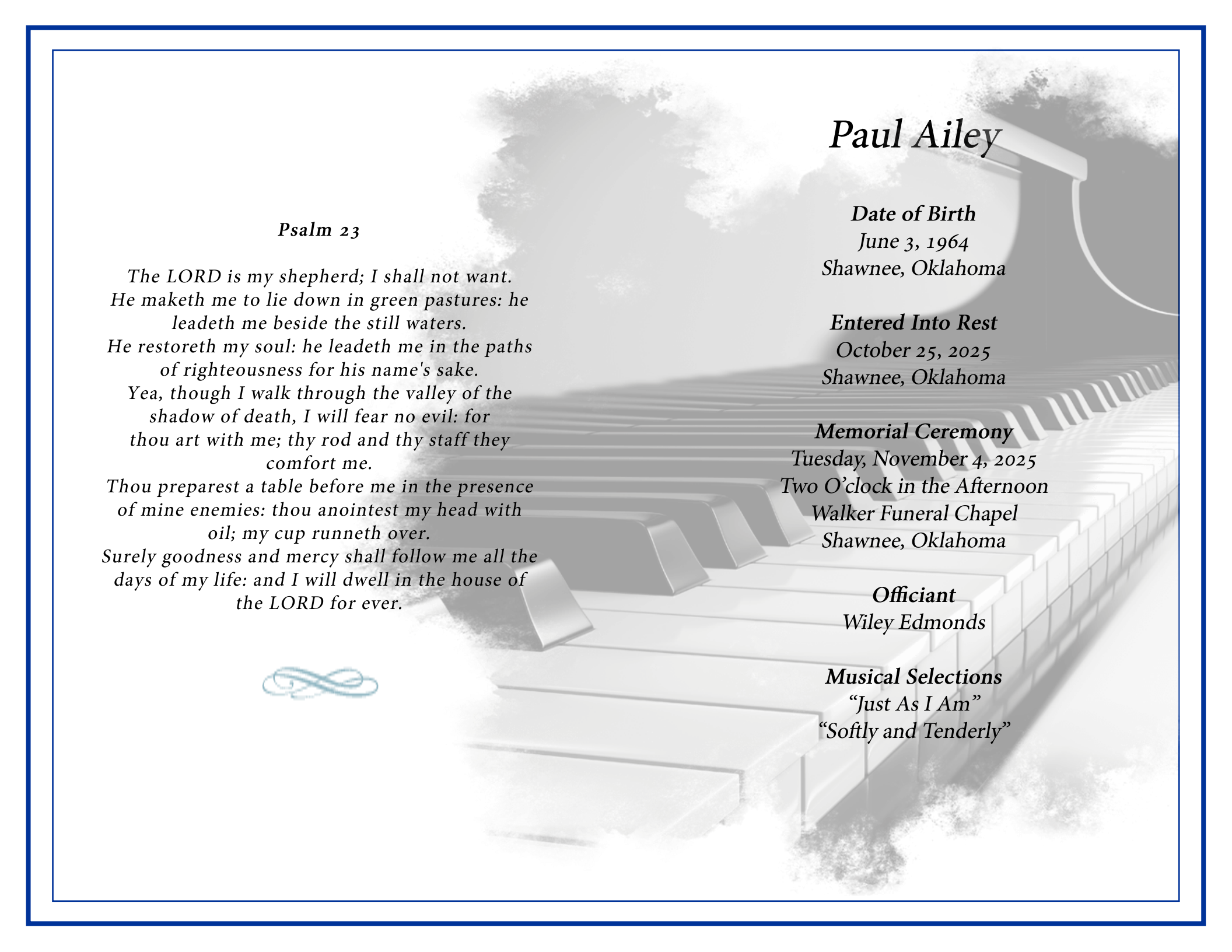
