


He was one of seven children (four boys and three girls). He graduated from Coatesville Area Senior High in 1975.

## *Life History*





Darrel was a good-spirited comedian to those who had the pleasure of making his acquaintance and his infectious Colgate smile would light up a room! He loved spending time with his family.


