Beyond the gates of pearl, I walk on golden streets.*

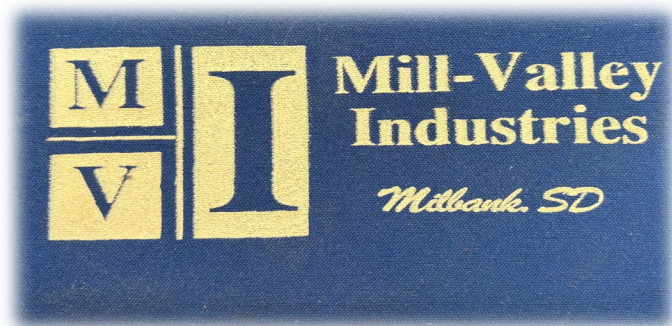
*I've touched the walls of jasper, dipped my

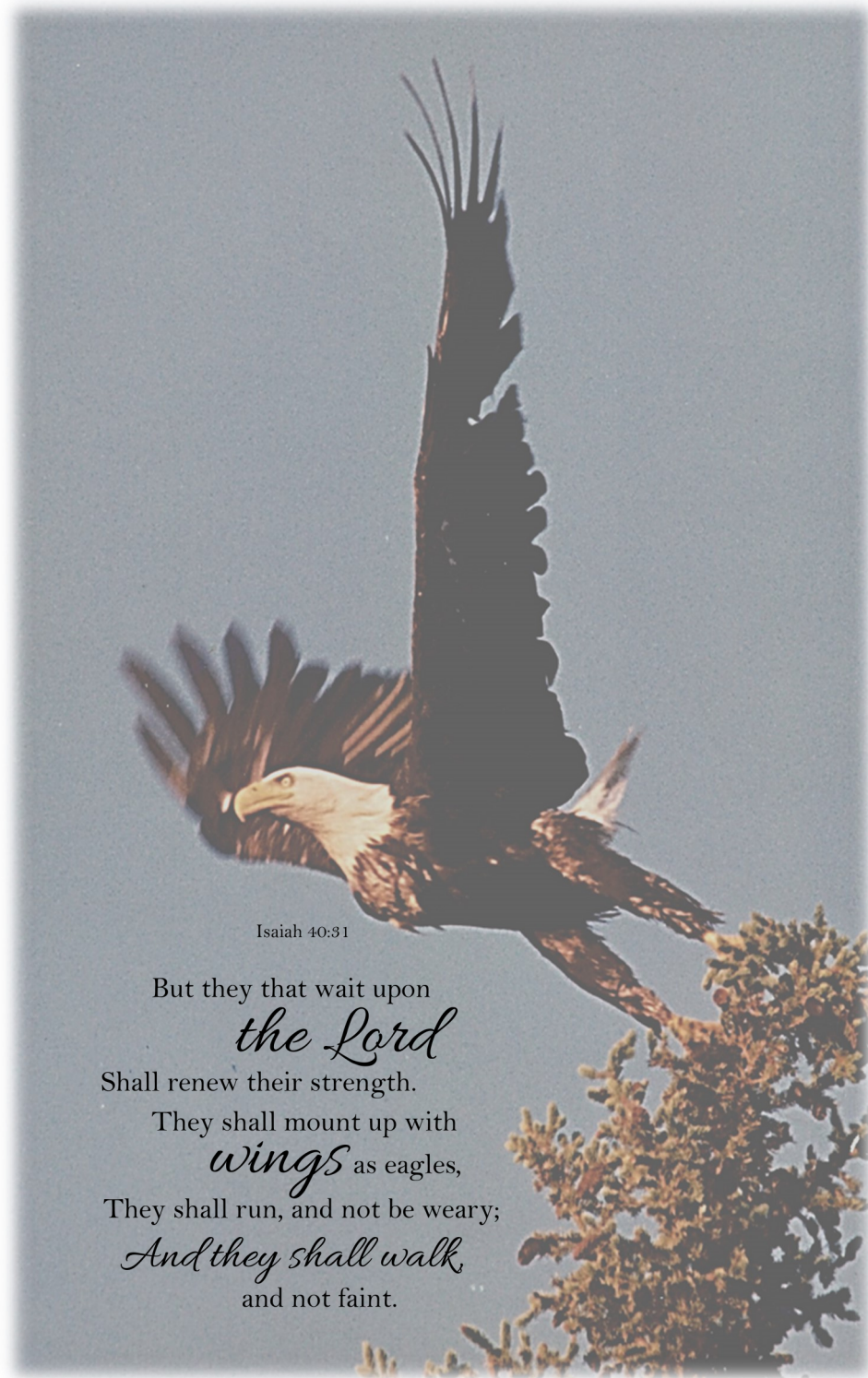
