Nyla Ardith Buchert, age 87, was born to Clifford and Doris Ruth (Holmstead) Buchert on November 16, 1937 at her home near Milroy, Minnesota. Nyla was delivered by her aunt who was a midwife. Her family later moved to Russell, Minnesota where she was raised with her 10 siblings. Nyla was baptized at Russell Baptist Church at 12 years old. She eventually met Louis and had a son, Michael (deceased at eight years old), later met Gordon VanLerberghe and was blessed with four children. Later in years, she met Edwin Ewald.
