


Cary A. Dequaine

Cary A. Dequaine, age 68, Champion, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday evening, December 30, 2025. He was born on September 1, 1957, to the late Walter E. Dequaine and Ann F. (Polasik) Dequaine.
