*Dr. William Charles Bosworth, 90, of Cleburne, Texas, passed away in his sleep on July 27, 2025 at home. He was born on March 31, 1935 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to Caroline Mason Bosworth and Harold Bosworth.*

*Charles graduated from The University of Oklahoma School of Medicine in 1960. After completing his residency and internship in Galveston, Texas, Dr. Bosworth served as a Lieutenant Commander in the United States Navy. After his time in the Navy, Dr. Bosworth practiced Internal Medicine and Cardiology in Wisconsin for a few years before establishing his practice in Cleburne, Texas in 1977.
