Retired Master Sgt. Gordon D. Ondriezek, 78 of Omaha, NE, died May 21, 2014, of natural causes at Ambassador Nursing Facilities in Omaha.


He was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Viola Ondriezek; his beloved wife, Kathleen Ondriezek; and sister, Jean Russell.
