Louis met and married his wife Louise J. Barney, who he loved dearly until she preceded him in death on September 5, 2022.

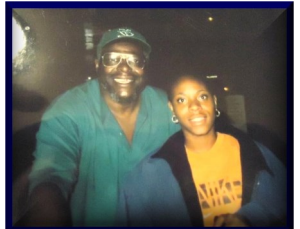
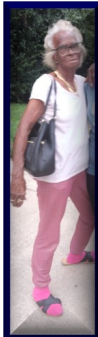
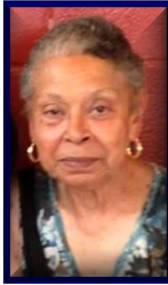
He left behind his three children—a son, Willie McFadden, a daughter, Regina Caldwell who he

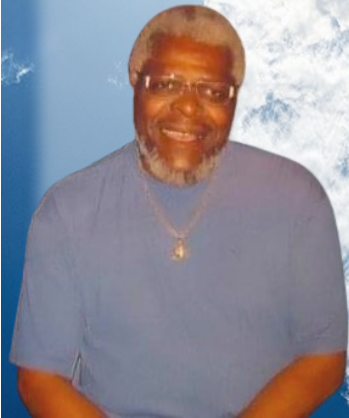
