For part of us went with you

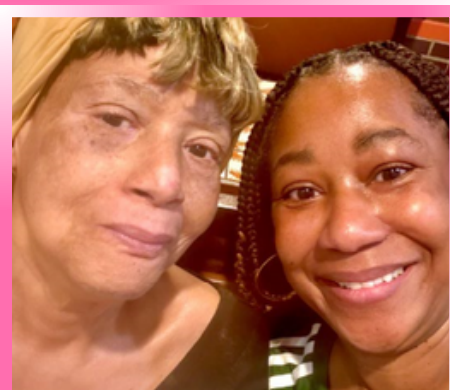
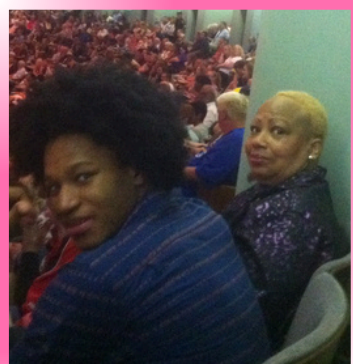
