Your sister,

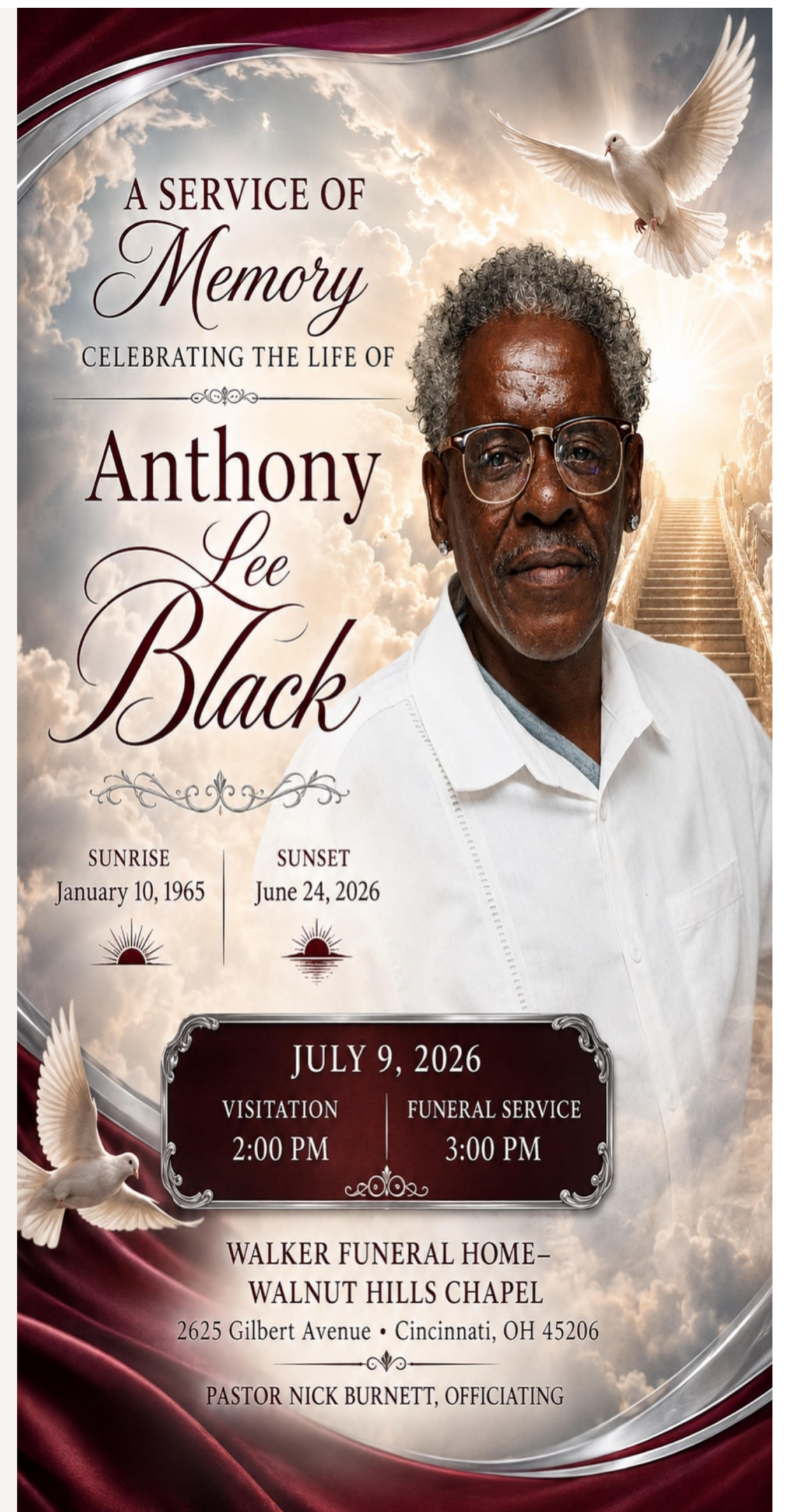
