ON JUNE 13, 1964 A BABY GIRL WAS BORN TO LEE ANDREW DAVIS SR AND FREDIA (FREDDIE) LEE WILEY IN WHARTON TEXAS, WHOM THEY NAMED NANETTE (NANNETTE) MARIE DAVIS. SHE WAS GIVEN THAT NAME BY HER AUNT NANCY WILEY HILL. NANNETTE ATTENDED DICKSON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND GRADUATE IN 1983. SHE WAS A MANAGER AT K-MART IN WEBSTER TX FOR A FEW YEARS. BEFORE SHE GOT MARRIED AND MOVED AWAY. THOUGH THE MARRIAGE DIDN'T LAST, ALONZO BAUGH I, WAS STILL HER BEST FRIEND.

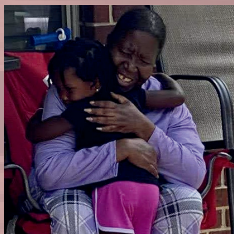
