RODERICK JOSEPH WARREN

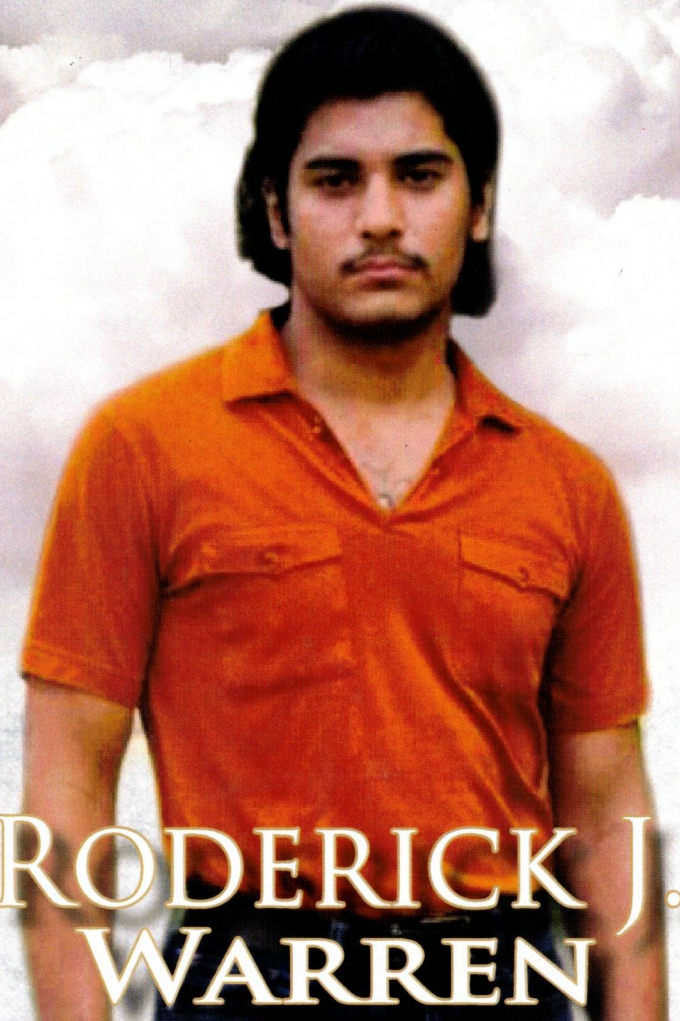
was born on May 22, 1955, in Detroit, Michigan to Roderick and Josephine Warren.
