Quamisha Nicole Davis, 31, of Coatesville, PA, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, June 29, 2025.

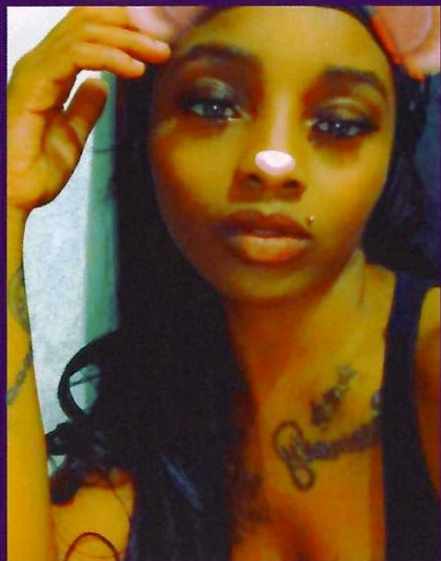
