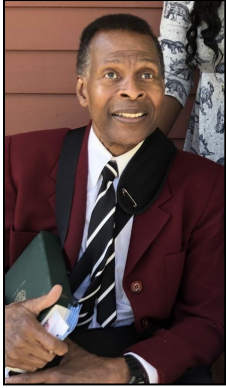


## *As We Look Back*

# Obituary



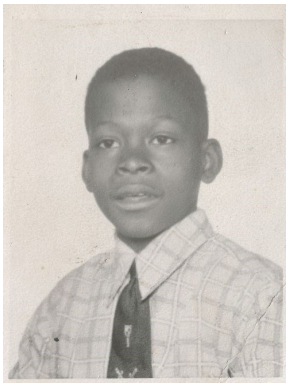
