The Broken Chain

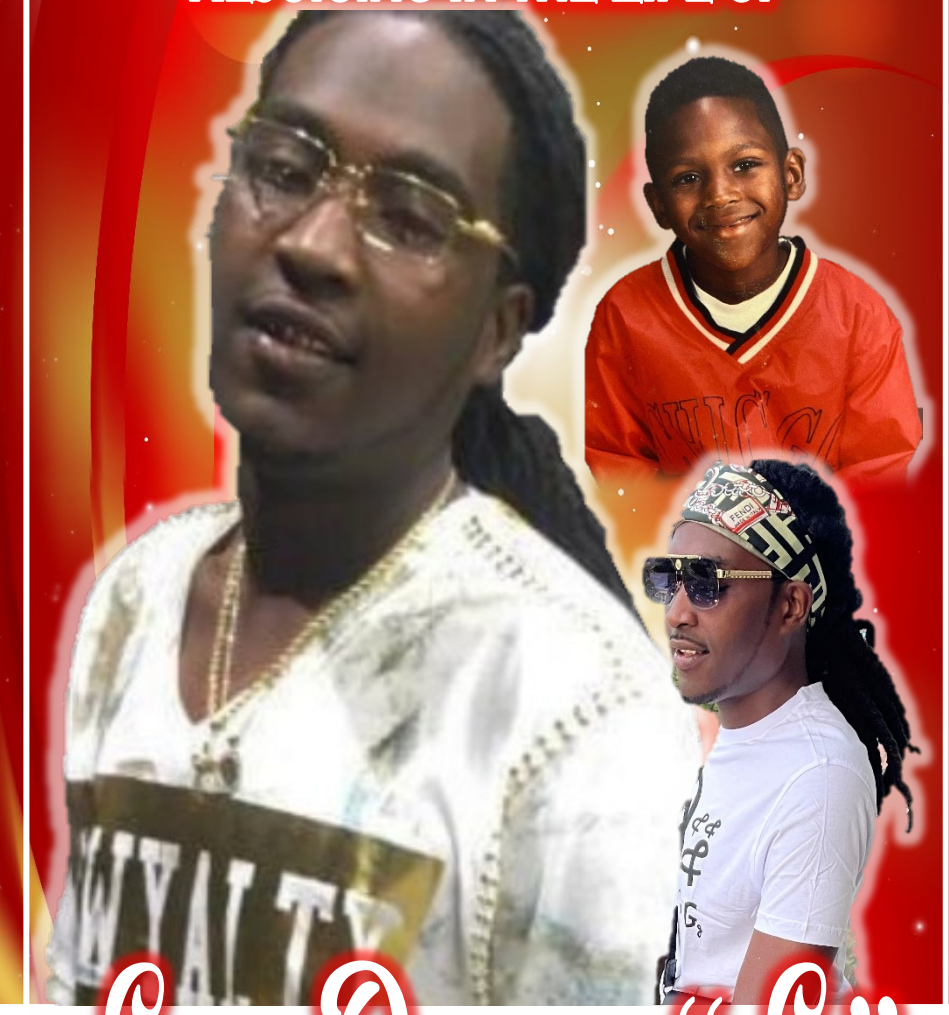
It broke our hearts to lose you, but you didn't go alone.
