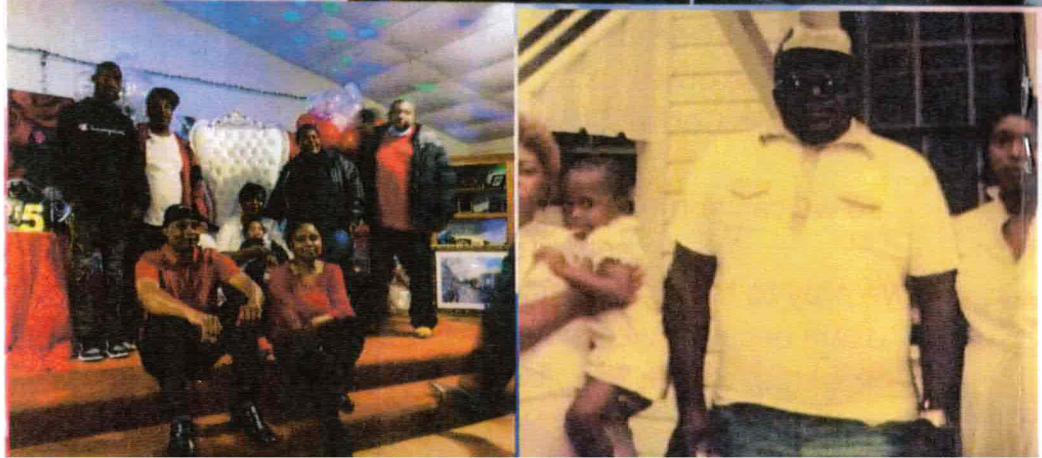

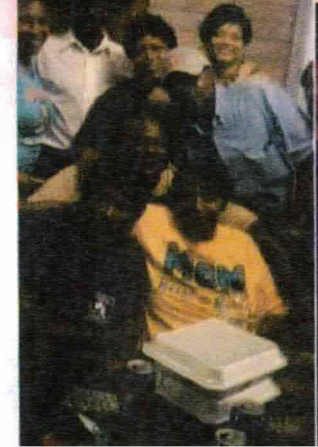
Obituary
