And always give more than you take*

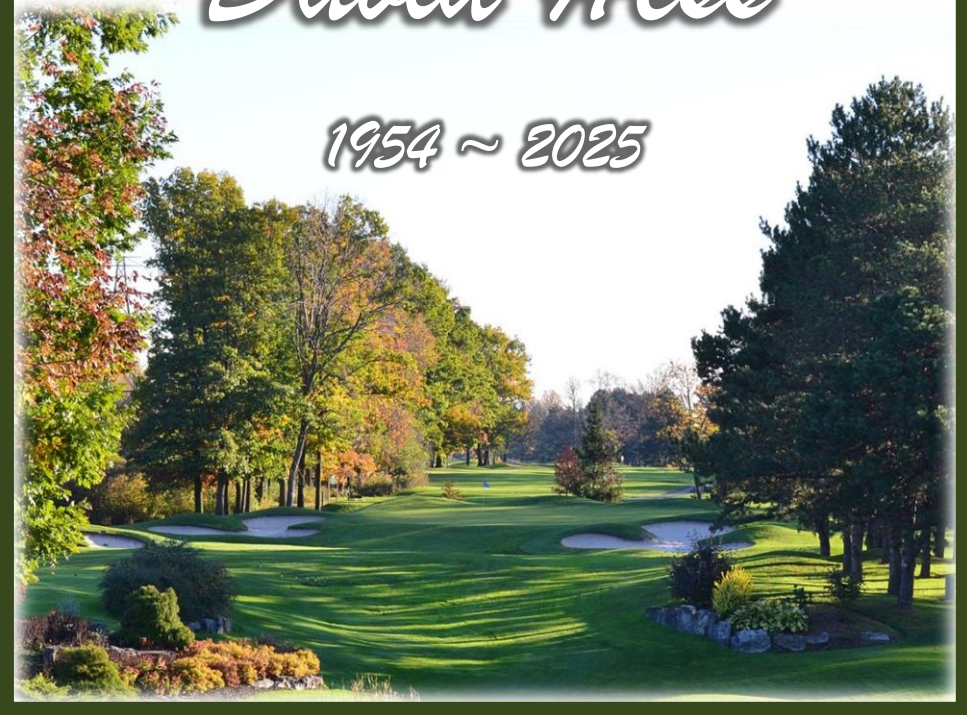
*But more than anything, yeah, more than anything
