But I will never leave you, I am here to keep you strong.



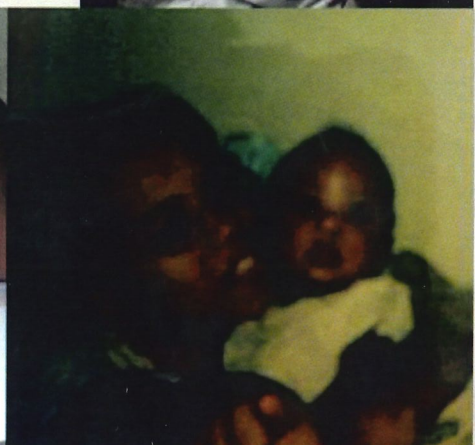
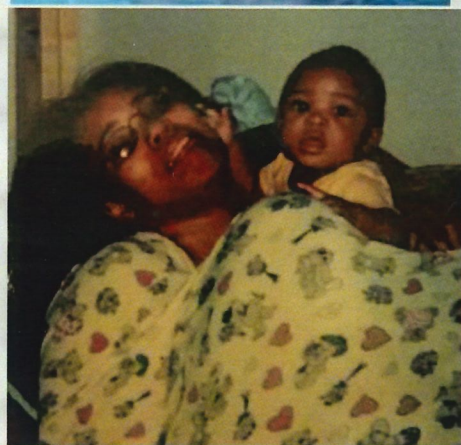
Talk to me I hear you, Though you may not see,

but in that broken heart you will forever remain.

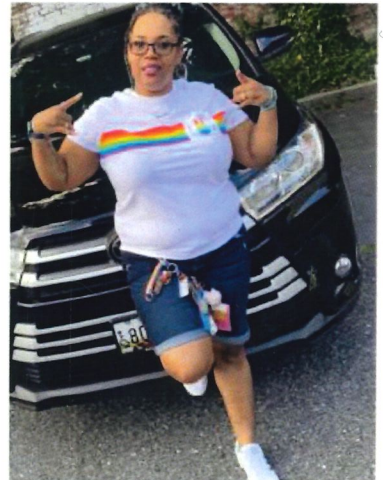
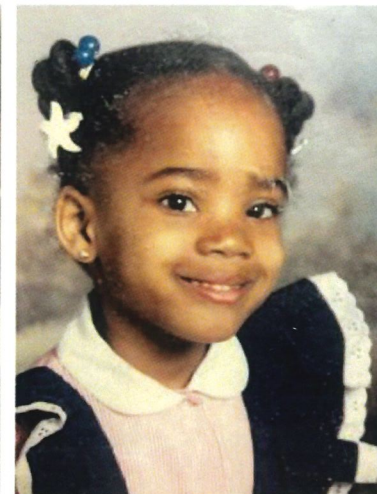
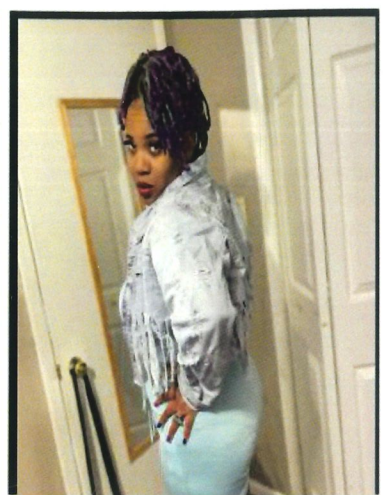
