

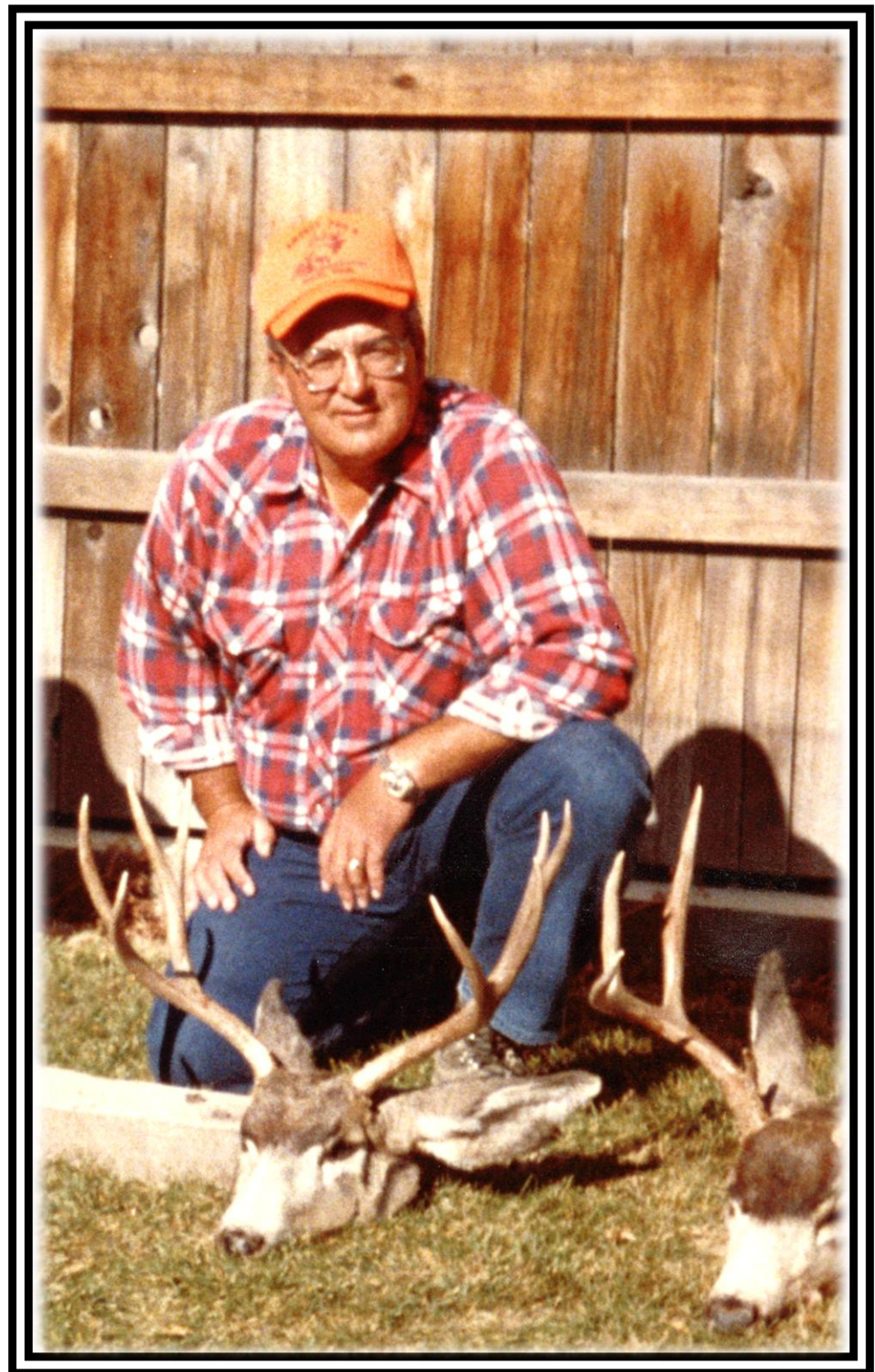


*I'm not your son, you're not my father
