LIFE Reflection

Evelyn Patricia Lee Brown, affectionately known as “Tricia” or “Tricia Lee,” was born on June 24, 1941, in Charleston, South Carolina, to Mary Grant Brown and George Holmes. She was educated in the Berkeley County public school system and went on to lead a life marked by dedication, service, and love for her family and community.

Evelyn worked at the Flower Garden on Highway 52 and later at the Magnolia Manor. She also lent her helping hands to many through domestic work. A woman of strong faith, Evelyn became a member of Moncks Corner Baptist Church at an early age. She was a devoted servant of the church, contributing her time and spirit as a member of the Usher Board, the Senior Choir, the Senior Missionary Society, and as a volunteer with the Soup Kitchen until her health no longer permitted.

She was also an active member of the Perry Hill Club and found joy in fellowship and community service. Her life was a testament to her favorite scriptures, Psalm 23 and Psalm 27, and her soul was often lifted by the songs “I Want Jesus to Walk with Me” and “I Need Thee Every Hour.”
