HIS STORY

Tyon “Ty” Makai Bias, 19, of White Plains, Maryland, passed away, leaving a lasting impression on all who knew him. Born in Washington, D.C., Ty grew from an outgoing, energetic child with a love for dancing into a quiet, laid-back, and chill young man whose warmth and gentle presence touched everyone around him.

As a child, Ty was full of life and loved to dance, often entertaining family with his smooth moves and playful impersonations of Michael Jackson and New Edition, a passion that stayed with him through the years. Even as he grew older and became more quiet and chill, his creativity and sense of humor shone through — whether he was making TikTok videos, joking with friends, or enjoying time at family gatherings.

Ty graduated in 2025 from St. Charles High School in Waldorf, Maryland. He had just obtained his driver’s license and was eagerly looking forward to buying his first car — a milestone he was excited to share with his family. He worked at Backyard Amusements as an event helper, bringing energy, care, and his cheerful personality to every event.

He was deeply bonded with his big brother, Damari Goddard, his sisters’ favorite little brother, and his first best friend, Antonio Cunningham, who preceded him in death. You filled ordinary moments with joy.

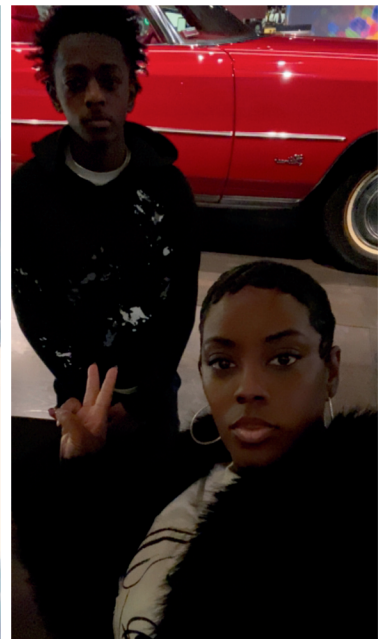
A part of me went with you,

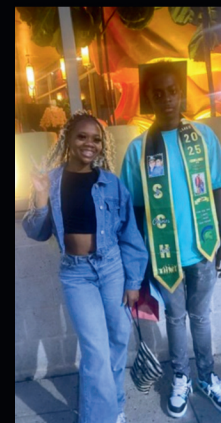
FOR TY
