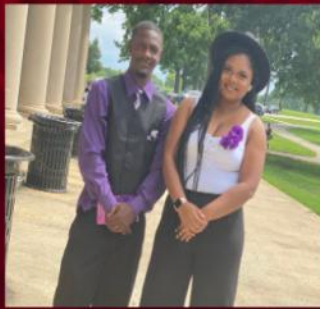
Celebrating THE LIFE & LEGACY
