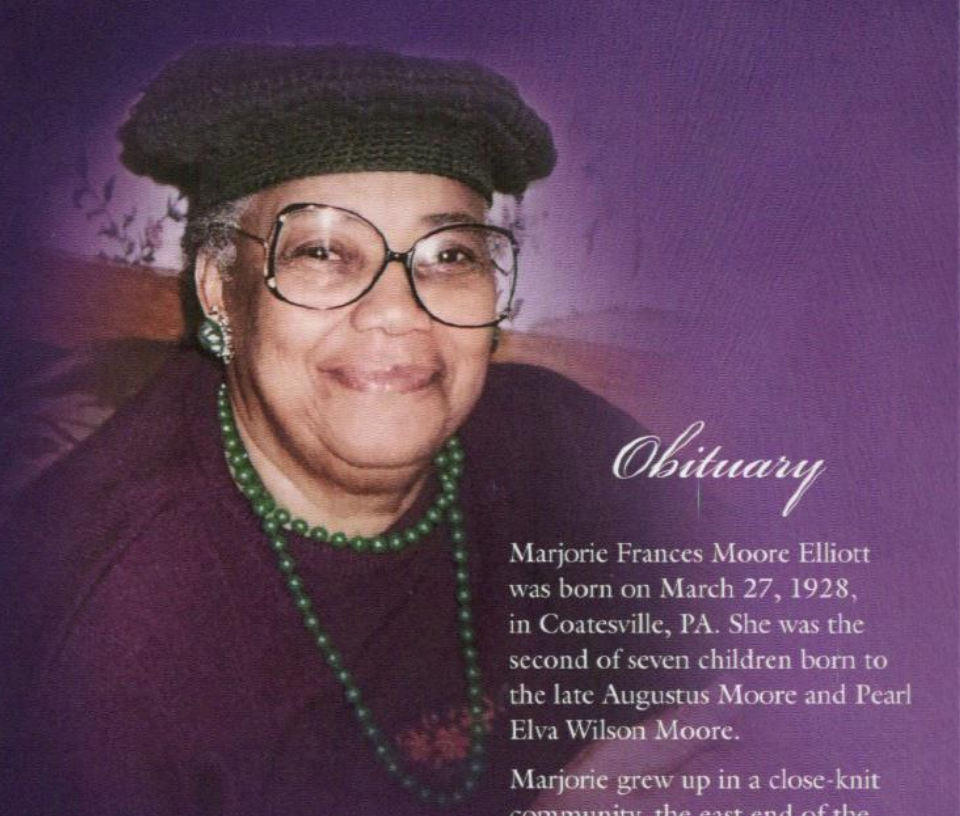

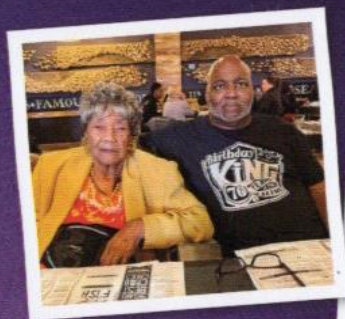


an indelible mark on her community. Her presence in church services and her outward expression of praise to the Lord will be dearly missed by all who knew her.

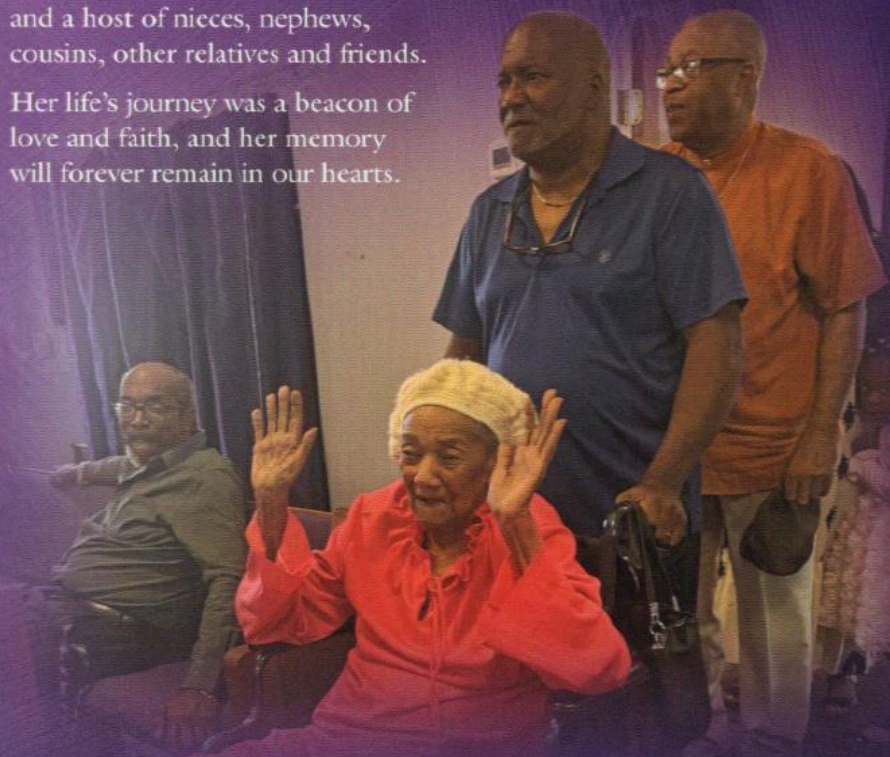

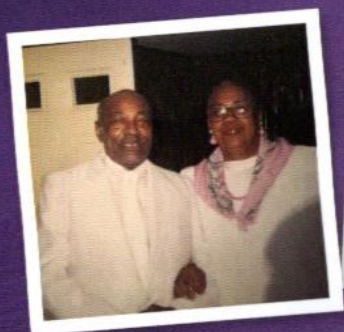
