

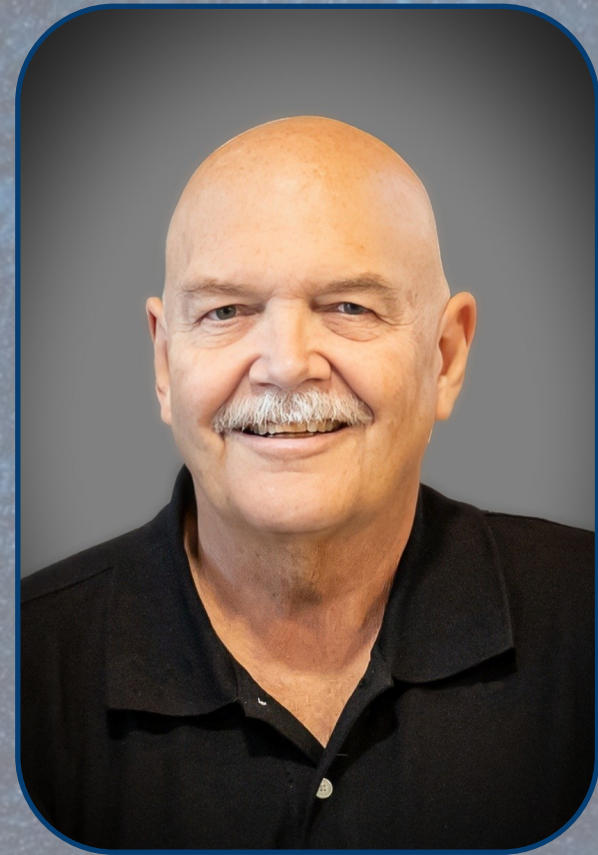
*A Message for my Children
