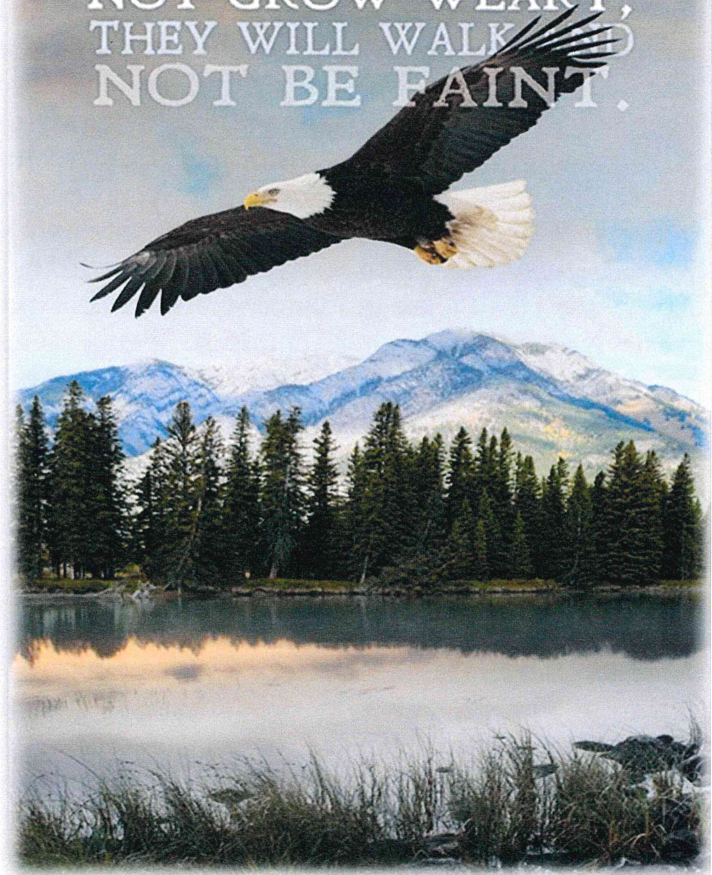


23rd Psalm

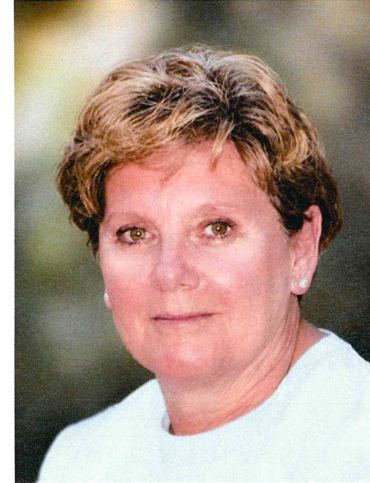
