Franklin Timothy Wilson was born on October 24, 1955, to Doretha James Wilson and the late James Wilson Sr., in Sumter County. He was called home by his heavenly father on June 13, 2026 at Prisma Health Tuomey.

“Frank,” as he was affectionately known by everyone was educated in the public schools of Sumter County and graduated from Sumter High School Class of 1973.

Frank entered the United States Air Force after graduation. During his years of service he worked as an aircraft electrician on the F-16 Fighter Jets. After his military career, he specialized in the mechanical, electrical, and industrial field. He used these skills as a maintenance worker with several companies in the Sumter area.
