

A time To Live

Mr. Richard Wesley Bradham was born January 17th 1956 in Savannah, Georgia, to the deceased Joseph Bradham Sr. and Vivian Catherine Johnson Bradham . The youngest of four siblings, Richard was treasured in his family and known for his infectious smile. Richard accepted Jesus Christ as his personal savior and was baptized at St. John Baptist Church in Savannah, Georgia.

Richard received his formal education at Coastal Center for Development Services, Inc. Where he began his career in 1972 working on the Quantum plant floor and kitchen before moving to the snack bar in the 1980s. Richard said that “ Running the snack bar was his life goal.” He also served on the CCDS board of directors from 1999 until 2015. Richard was very active in the Employee Association, an agency-based group which operated Richard’s Canteen and scheduled recreational events.

Coastal Center for Development Services celebrated the grand opening of a newly remodeled snack bar in June of 2003 where they named it after Richard. They also held a ribbon cutting ceremony in Richard’s honor where he was able to cut the opening ribbon on the new snack bar. He was so honored. He retired from CCDS in December 2016 after 24 years of service.

A Time To Die

On Sunday, December 14th 2025, Richard transitioned from this temporal state to his eternal state. The love and deep affection this great man had for his family and friends would not only be forgotten but severely missed. He was preceded in death by his parents Joseph Bradham Sr. and Vivian Catherine Johnson Bradham and his sister Joanne Bradham.
