

Grace Opal McEvers (Bredemeier) was born on August 26, 1932, in Moorhead, MN to Alfred and Oma (Slyter) Bredemeier. She was the youngest of five daughters. Grace attended 1st grade at the country school $\frac{3}{4}$ miles NW of the farm. The rest of her schooling was in Barnesville, MN. She graduated from Barnesville High School in 1950.

Grace married Wayne McEvers on March 28, 1953, in a double wedding with her sister, Lois and Elton Klug. Grace and Wayne had three sons, Douglas, Larry, and David. She was an active member in the St. James Church, singing in the choir, playing the organ and piano. Grace spent many springs working at Thompson Greenery alongside her best friend, Eileen Thompson. She also worked at Gambles Hardware and was a ClayCo. Assessor for four townships.

Grace was an avid gardener and had many beautiful flower beds. Much of the garden produce was preserved. Grace and Wayne vacationed in many locations, often traveling with Al and Lois Klug.
