Your Grandkids

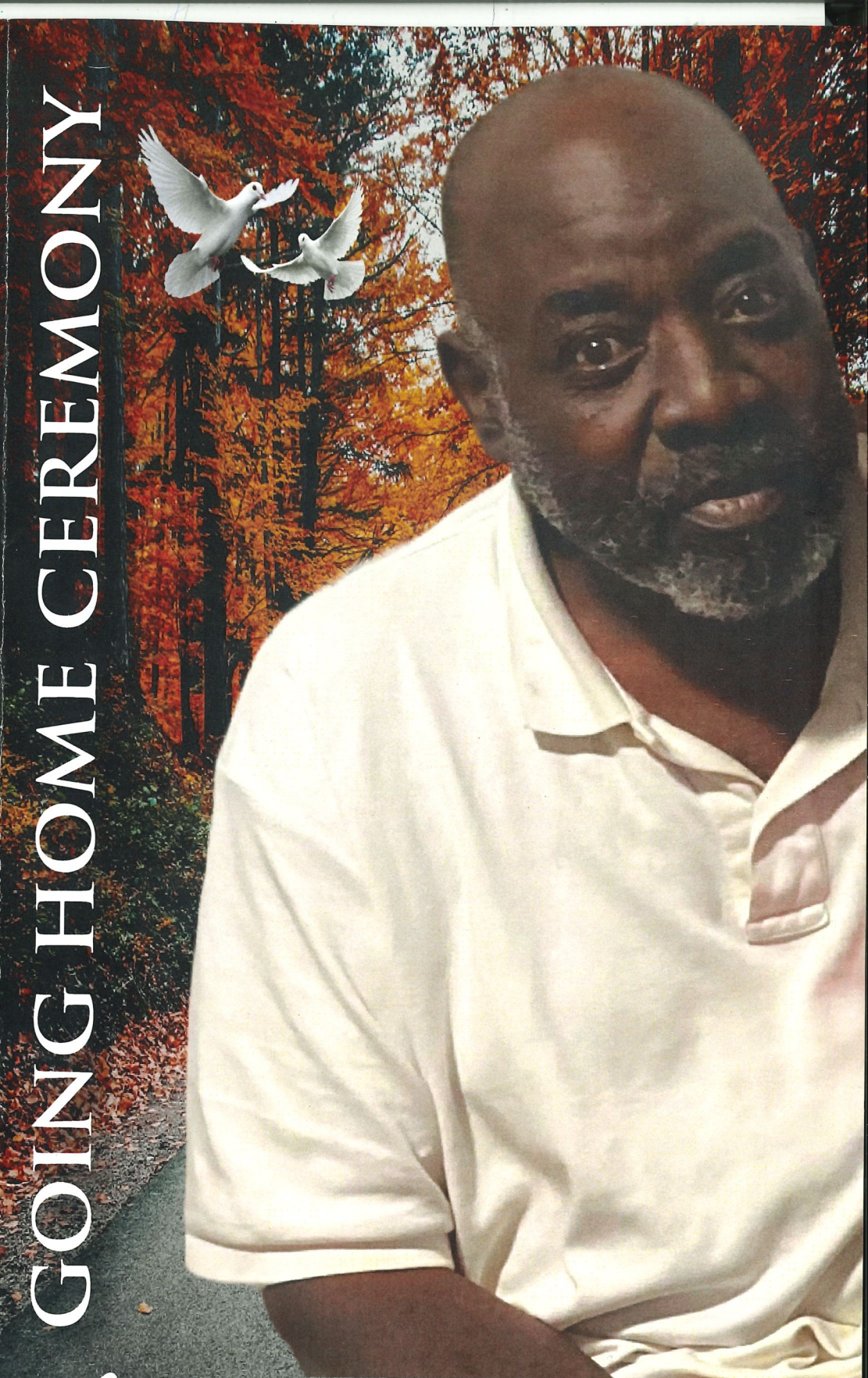

# Arvin Charles Sampson

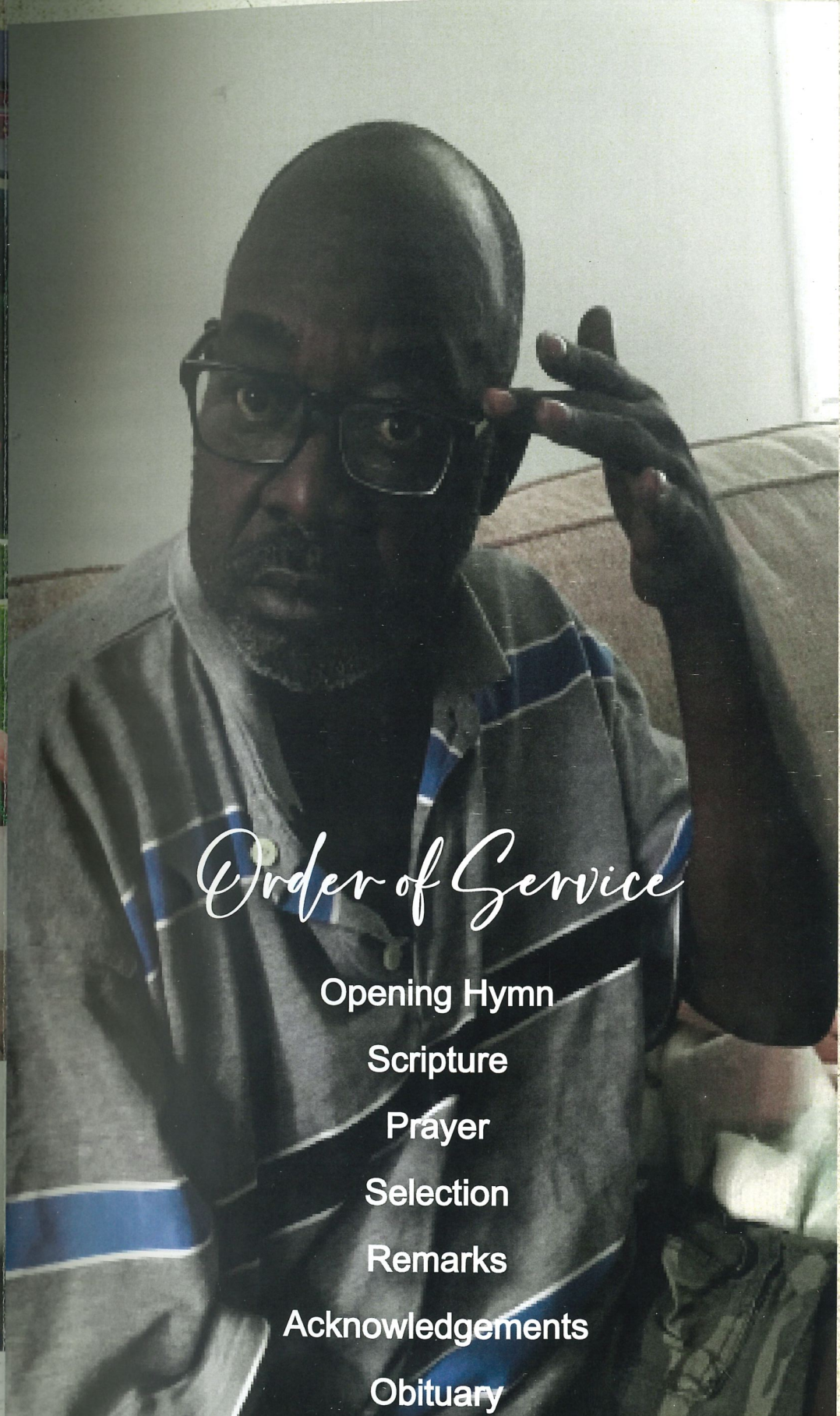
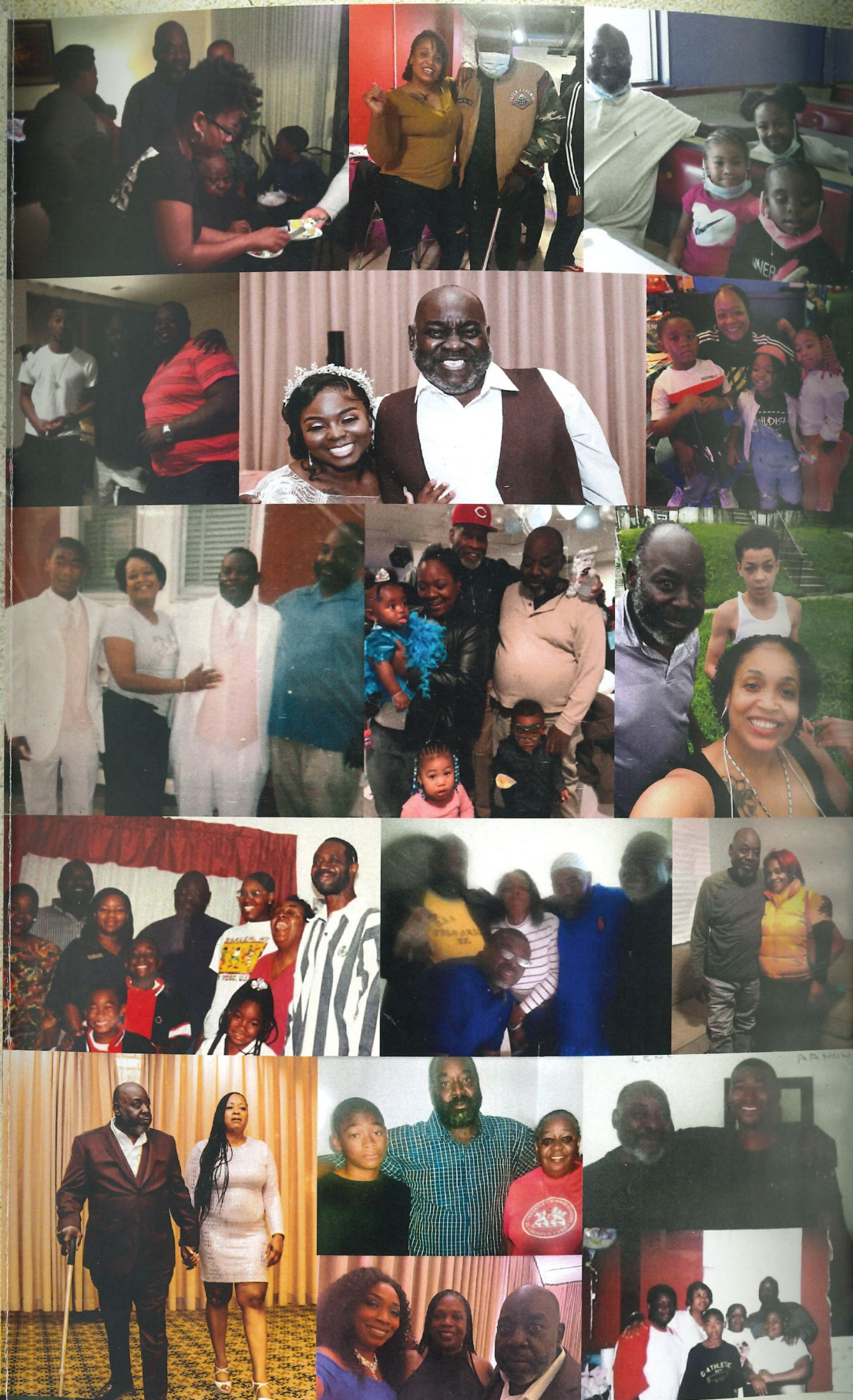
