name's sake.*

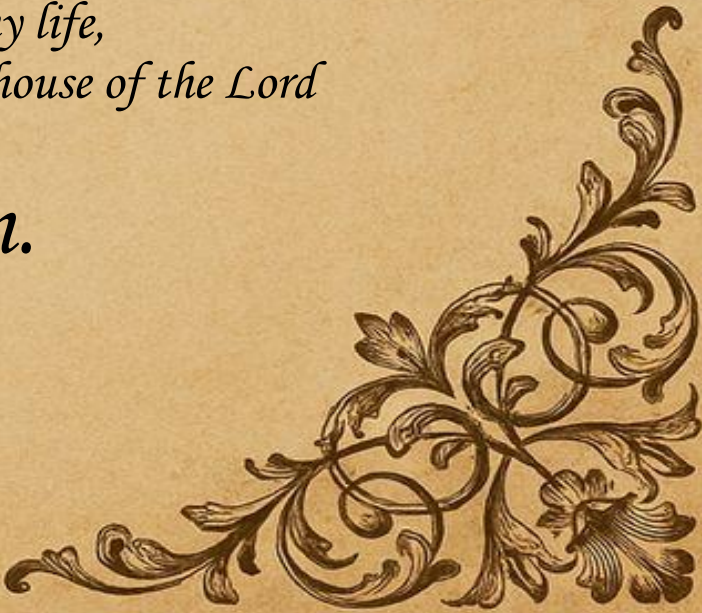
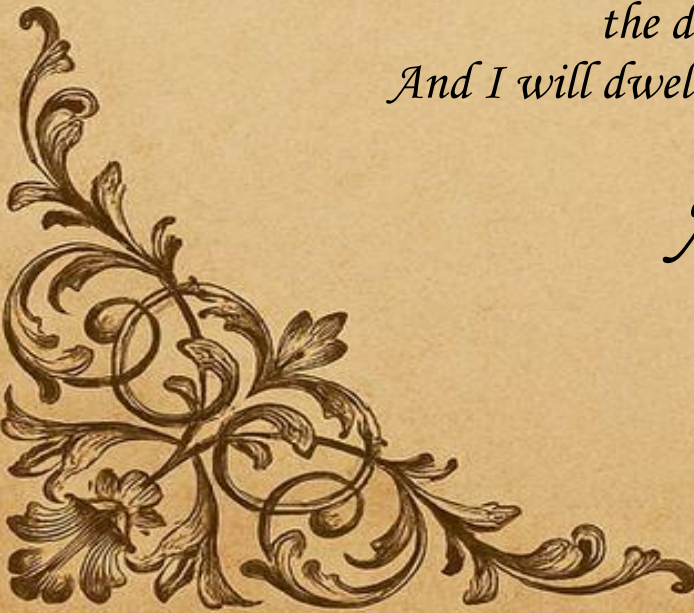
*Yea, though I walk through the valley of the

and bless his name.*

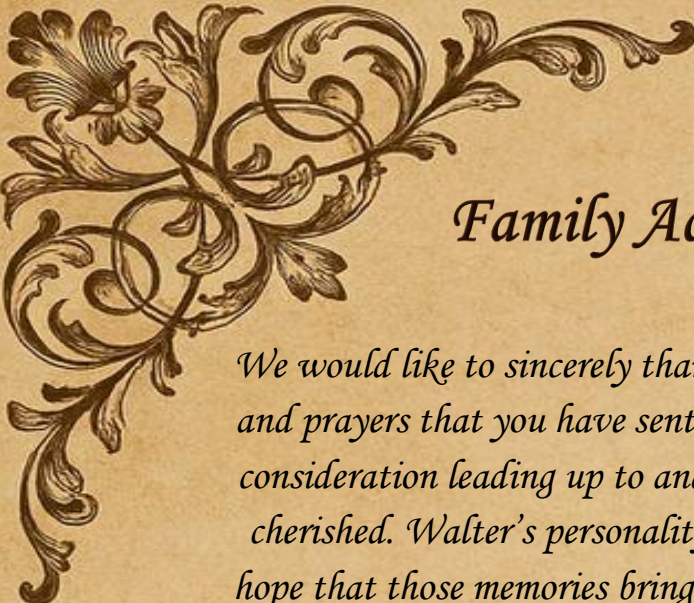
*For the Lord is good;
