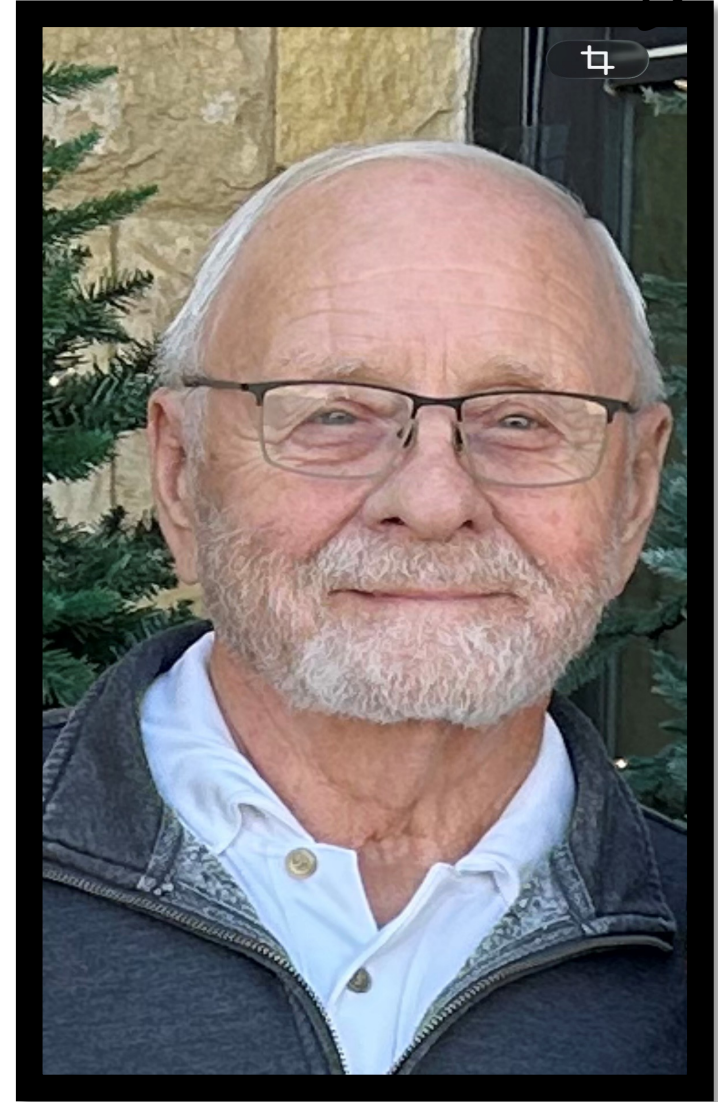
He is preceded in death by his parents, Hartwell and Thea; sisters, Betty Moen and June Johnson and brother, Blair Burner.
