

Robert Lee was raised in the Oldfield section of St. Stephen, SC and was educated in the public schools of Berkeley County. Upon graduating from Russellville High School, he attended Trident Technical College where he received an Associate Degree in Welding. For many years, he was employed as a welder at J.W. Aluminum in Goose Creek, SC.

As a young man, Robert Lee was a member of St. Matthew Baptist Church where is attended faithfully until he became an adult.

In the late seventies, he married the late Lucy Mae Gethers of Pineville, SC. This union was blessed with eight children. Altreana and Alicia preceded him in death.
