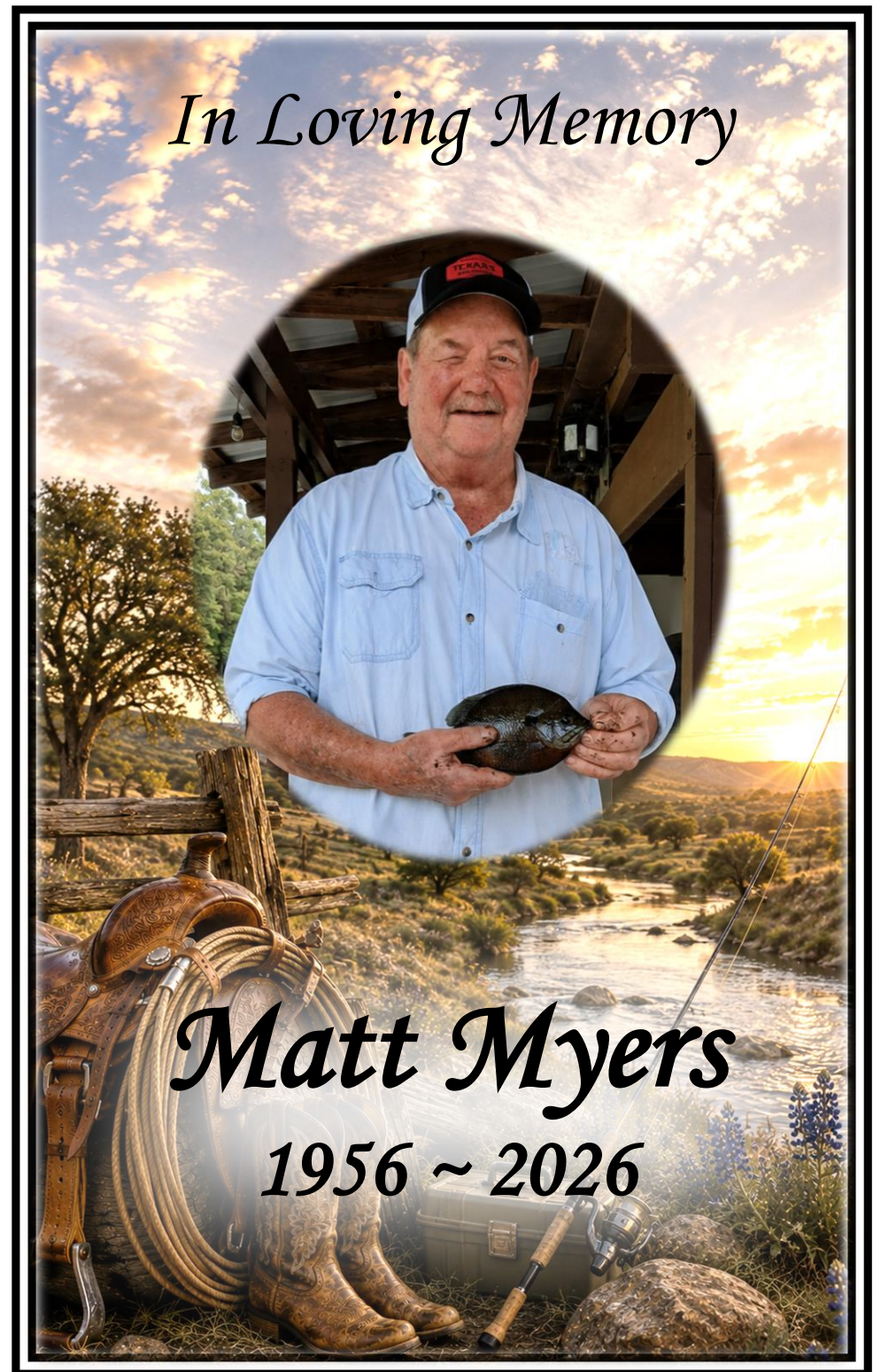


Matt loved playing in the rain as much as he loved playing in the dirt.
