Thou anointest my head with oil;

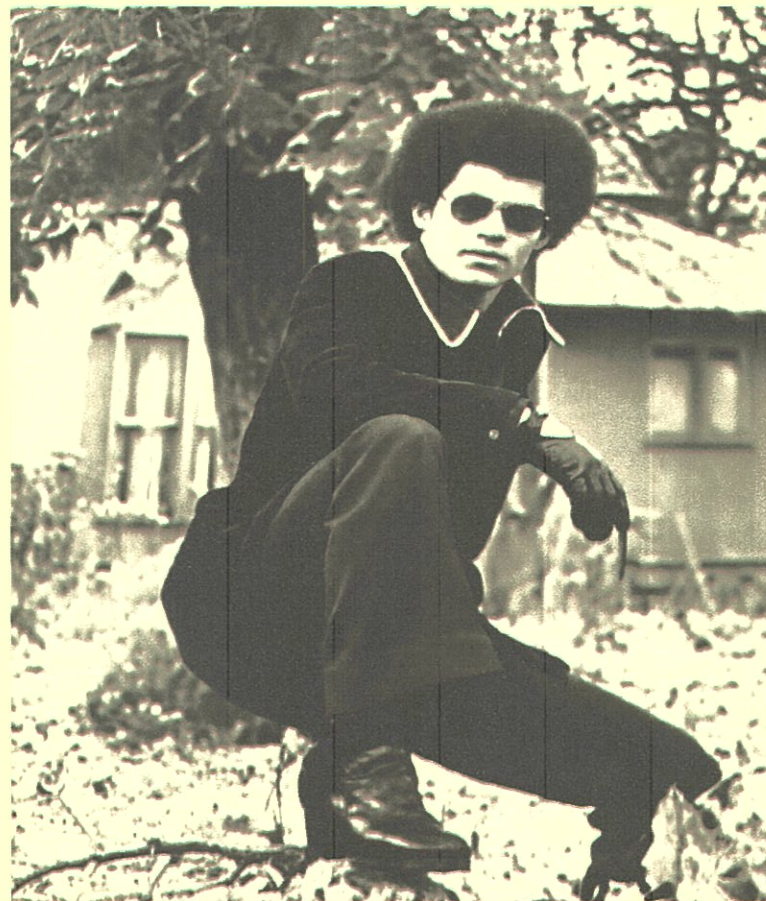
My cup runneth over.

And I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.



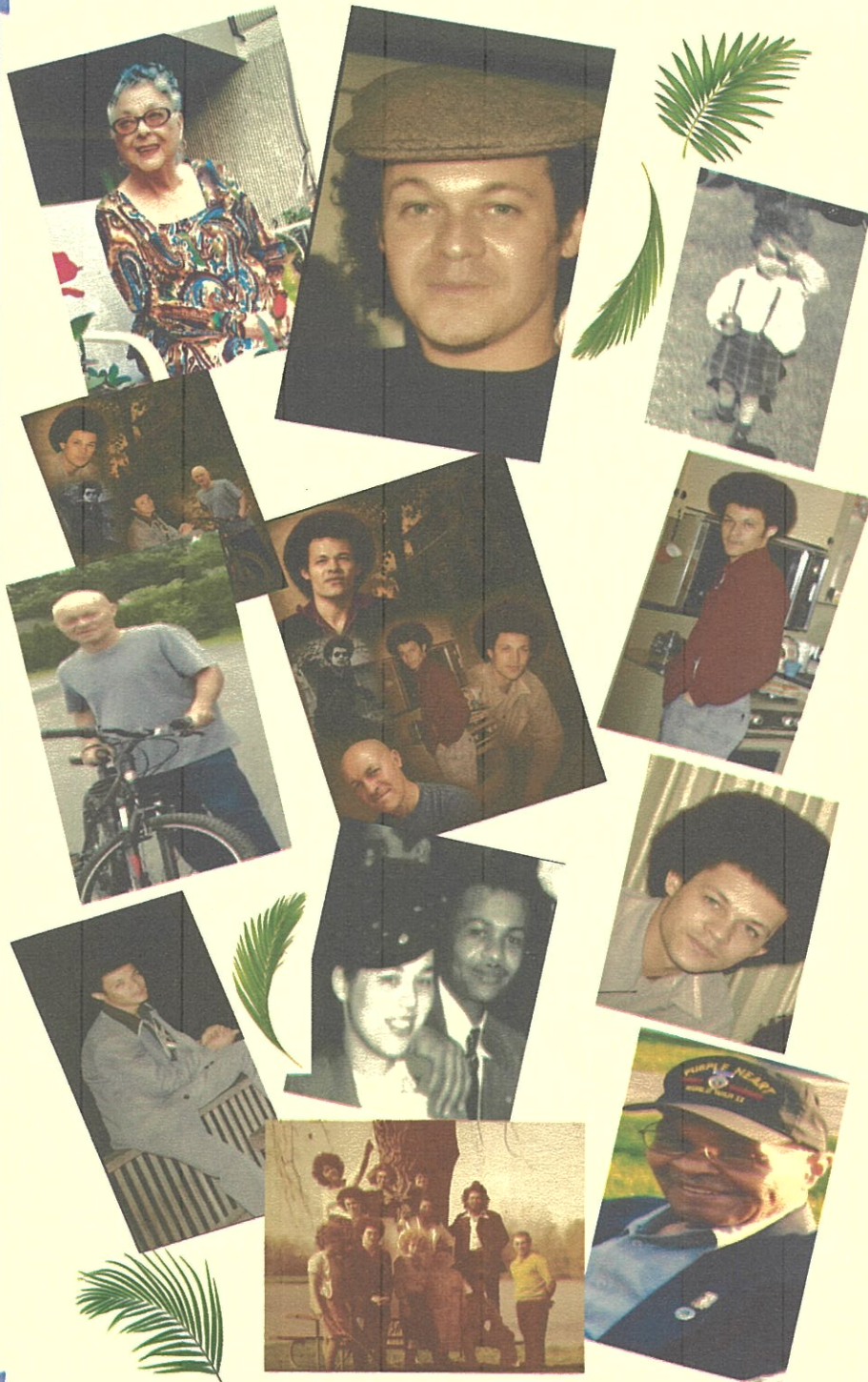
In Celebration of Life For Anthony Ray Pruitt
