Saralynn Love Earl (née Pogue) was born into this world on February 8, 1961, and left far too soon on September 5, 2025. She was born at Fort Carson near Colorado Springs, Colorado, to Zack Alphonso and Sara Love Pogue, and throughout her life also called Tucson, Arizona, and Las Vegas, Nevada, home.

Saralynn was a woman of strength, compassion, intelligence, and determination. She excelled in many sports in her youth, including synchronized swimming, basketball, volleyball, and track and field, in which she still holds a record at Palo Verde High School in Tucson, AZ.

Saralynn was truly a servant of the people, especially in Las Vegas—working for Oscar Goodman while he was in office as Mayor of Las Vegas, and later for the Southern Nevada Housing Authority. Ultimately, she dedicated herself to education and professional growth, as education was deeply important to her. She earned a Master of Arts in Organizational Management from the University of Phoenix, where she later served as a Site Manager at the Nellis Air Force Base Learning Center, specifically working with active-duty military personnel and veterans to enrich their lives and careers through higher education. She served the Las Vegas community with back-to-school drives, donating computers and school supplies, and was a proud parent volunteer at Faith Lutheran High School. Not only did her work and volunteerism reflect her belief in lifelong learning and helping others reach their greatest potential, but she also sacrificed much to ensure each of her children received the best education available—ultimately leading each of them to enroll in college and advance their own lives.

Above all, she was a devoted mother. Her children Zachary (Ryan Pyles), Atianna (Dennis Walker), and Melijah were the center of her world, and she instilled in them values of resilience, kindness, and love. She was also a mother figure to many beyond her own children, including her nieces and nephews, as well as anyone who sought her kindness and comfort. Her presence was a source of care and guidance, and her memory will live on in their hearts forever.

She had many interests and hobbies, including reading, art collecting, cooking, hosting, and gardening. She maintained gorgeous gardens and a greenhouse full of fruits, vegetables, and stunning flowers such as hibiscus and roses—all while caring for her parents and brother in the hot Arizona desert.

In recent years, Saralynn bravely faced a difficult battle with Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML), a blood cancer with a harrowing survival rate. She fought fiercely through the pain and challenges, exceeding all of her providers' expectations, while focusing on the day she would be able to say she had won and could embrace those who loved her with open arms. Though the illness brought many hardships, she endured with courage and grace, surrounded by the love of her family. Through a successful initial bone marrow transplant, she was able to extend her life and, during that time, experience the joy of becoming a grandmother.

Saralynn's legacy will live on not only in the lives of her family and friends, but also in the example of strength through adversity that she embodied and inspired in others. She leaves to cherish her memories: her brothers and sister, her children, a grandson, and a bonus granddaughter. She now joins her mother and father in eternal rest.


