OBITUARY

Rev. Cyrus Green, 75, of Asbury Park, New Jersey passed away on October 28, 2016. He was born in Charleston, South Carolina to Cyrus and Daisy Green on January 16, 1941.

Rev. Green's family moved to Asbury Park, New Jersey when he was nine years old. He graduated from Neptune High School, Neptune, New Jersey. He was introduced to Miss Eula Cephus in 1965, they were married in 1975. Two children were born to this union.

Rev. Green joined Friendship Baptist Church, Asbury Park, New Jersey in 1979. He was a member of the Senior Choir, Male Chorus, served on the Deacon Board for twelve years, and was board chairman.

Rev. Green loved God, his family and his Church. He received his calling into the ministry of Jesus Christ in April 1995. **Rev. Green** was Superintendent of Sunday School, Associate Minister of Friendship Baptist Church, a Worship Leader, and Vice President of Mission and Bible study. He was a graduate of Monmouth Bible Institute, served as secretary of the Deacon's Union of Monmouth and adjacent counties, a member of Asbury Park/Neptune Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance, and served as the treasurer.
