And loyal friendship give

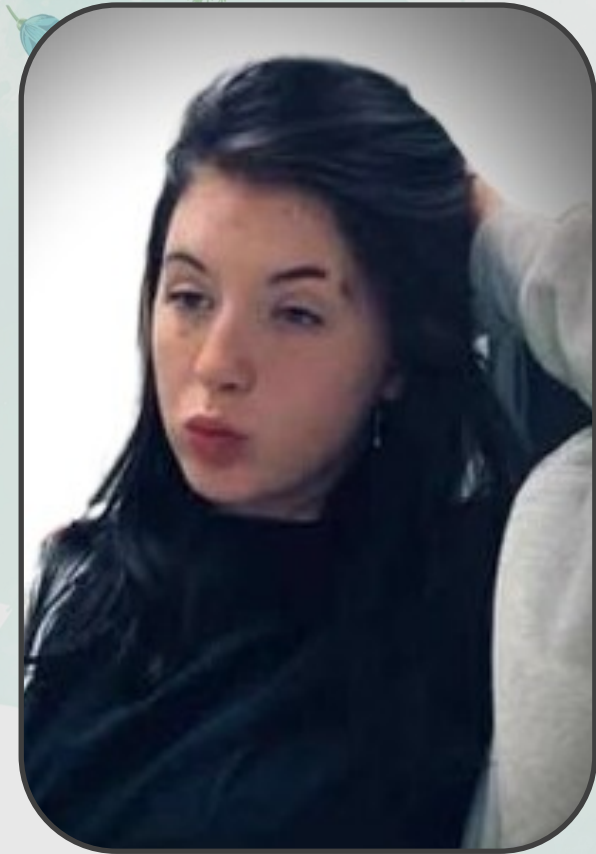
Your presence was a light and a joy
