

Victor Nelson Hunsicker, age 75, passed away on Friday, May 12, 2023 after a long battle with dementia.

Victor was born on March 5, 1948 in Norman, Oklahoma to the late Jack and Earline Hunsicker. He served his country proudly in the Third Armored Division of the United States Army. After leaving the army, Victor started working as an electronics mechanic at McClellan Air Force Base repairing radio equipment and was later promoted to logistics management.
