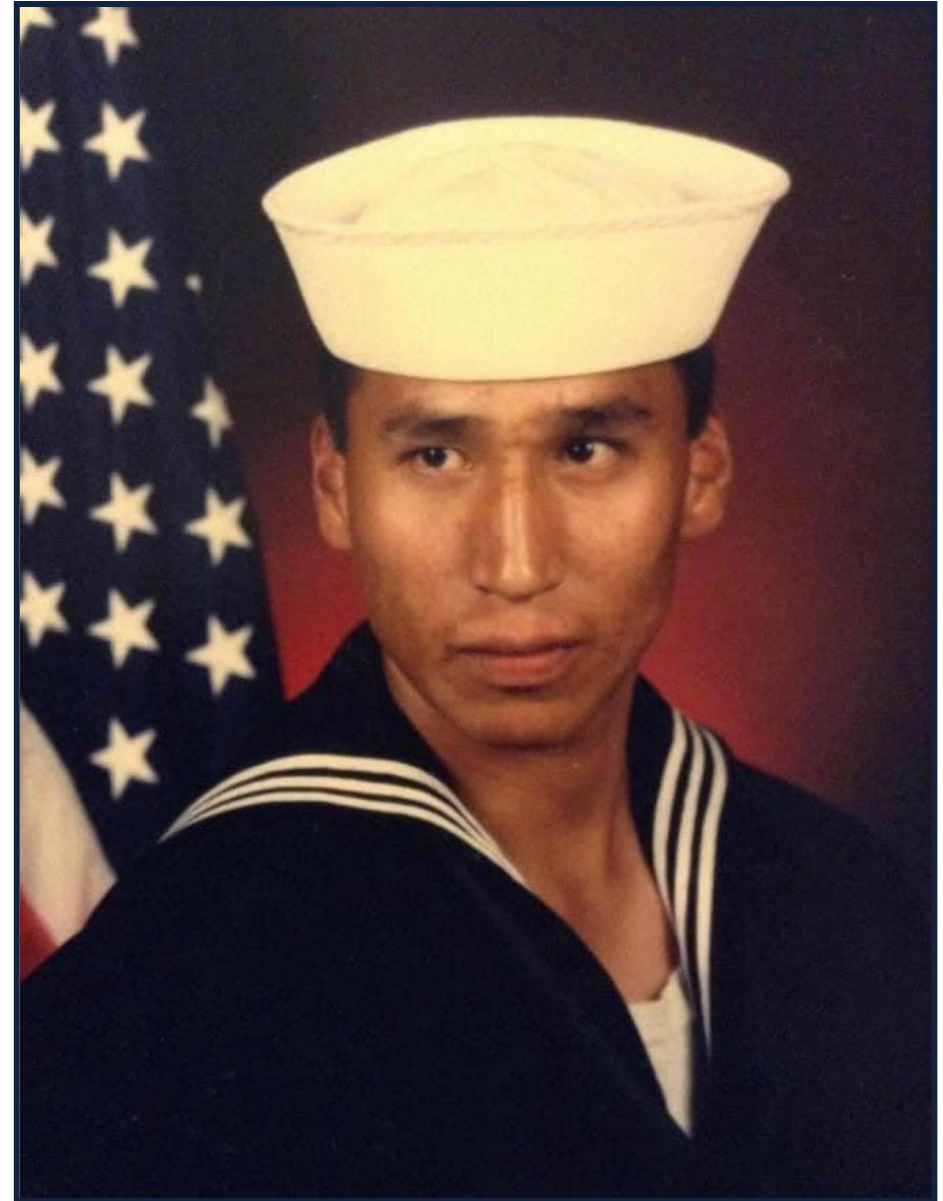
*On October 7, 1986, Justin enlisted in the U.S. Navy and was Honorably Discharged on November 30, 1990.*
