## Life Reflections

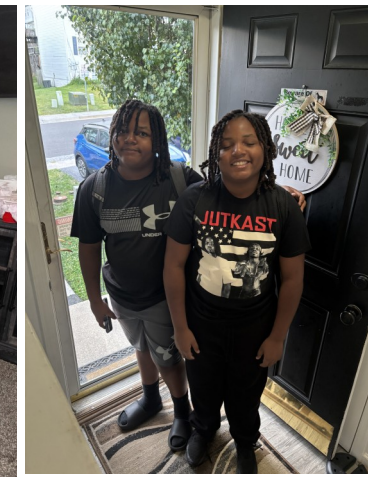

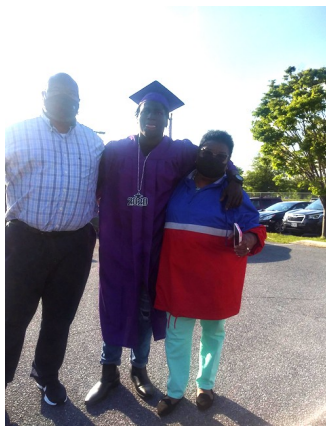
