Daisy Marie Jones was born to parents Lillian S. Bolt and David Bolt in 1938 in Shreveport, Louisiana. Daisy Marie became active in the church at an early age. She was baptized at age 10 years and united with Galilee Baptist Church in Dubberly, LA and belonged to the youth department and youth choir. She received her elementary and high school education in Louisiana, college and Nurses license acquired in California.

Daisy Marie and Charlie Odom were married in Louisiana in 1956 and then were relocated to Los Angeles, CA. To this union one son Ricky Lane Odom was born. In 1958 the family united with St. Rest Baptist Church, under Reverend H. V. Jordan, Pastor. Daisy Marie worked as a First Aider with the usher board. She was a member there for 19 yrs.

In 1977 Daisy Marie united with the St. Andrews Baptist Church of Los Angeles, CA. with Rev. Alex Toussaint as Pastor. She served as a Sunrise Usher and a member of the Promoters League Mission Auxiliary. She was known to never say NO to a task she was asked to do. It was always Yes, I will try that for you. She believed God would always direct her to do what needed to be done when she asked him.

Daisy Marie was a diligent community worker as Block Club Captain in her Los Angeles neighborhood and Council District Secretary for the neighborhood in the 8th Council District. She was also a special helper to the neighborhood seniors.

In 1986 Daisy Marie married Wallace H. Jones and relocated to Layton, Utah with him. She united with True Vine Baptist Church of Layton, UT with Rev. Grover Walker as Pastor. Her Christian works continued as Usher, Deaconess, Youth Usher Supervisor and Assistant Finance Secretary of the Intermountain General Baptist Association (IGBA) of Idaho, Utah, and Wyoming. She served wherever and whenever needed in her church membership.

Daisy Marie was dedicated to her Lord, her husband, family, and community work. If there was a way to help someone, she always found it. In December of 1997 Wallace was retired and he and Daisy Marie relocated to Las Vegas, Nevada. They united with the Word of Life Christian Center under Pastors David & Vicki Shearin. Daisy Marie became a Greeter, Prayer Room Worker, Member of Ladies Life Style Bible Studies, and LifeWise Auxiliary Group (Member age 55+). She was a member of WIN (Widows in the Neighborhood), a widows military group sponsored by Nellis Airforce Base Chaplain and some Airforce retired couples.

Earthly works finished, she returned to the Heavenly Father on May 3, 2026. No more cares of this earthly world. She left a beautiful example one could follow to meet her again in that eternal home.
