Some of her other pastimes were bowling, softball, and volleyball. She was not one to let grass grow under her feet. She always had some activity she was going to. Even at the age of 84, she was still playing card games and board games with her friends in her apartment complex.

Mary died Friday, July 11, 2025 at Good Samaritan Society in Tyndall. She was 84 years old.
