
"In the blink of an eye, everything can change. So, forgive often and love with all your heart. You may never not have that chance again."

Boyce Edward Jarrett was born on October 12, 1946, in Lincolnton, North Carolina to the union of Victor Marvin Jarrett and Versilee Carrie Jarrett. Boyce attended Newbold High School in Lincolnton, North Carolina. Boyce enlisted in the U. S. Army on August 9, 1973, at Ft. Knox, Kentucky and was honorably discharged on May 2, 1979, from Ft. Dix, New Jersey, having served two tours in Vietnam, where he received his parachutist badge and the National Defense Service Medal. He was a Freemason.
